Public Question Time 5.

A representative of the Exhibition Road tenants addressed the meeting expressing concerns pertaining to public liability insurance in respect of tenants.

Councillor Adams arrived.

Questions from Council were put to PC R Curtis present. The vandalism of the War Memorial Bus Shelter notice board was reported.

Councillor Nation arrived.

GENERAL PURPOSES (items for discussion and determination)

It was agreed to bring forward the Allotments agenda item.

6. Allotments.

a) Matters raised by tenants.

It was agreed the Council would host a meeting of tenants to discuss the public liability insurance issues at the Old Town Hall. Clerk to organise.

b) Tenancies and Rents.

A report was tabled detailing numbers of tenants who had returned the new signed tenancy agreement, and outstanding rents. The report included the findings of the May allotments inspection, details of some insurance options available to tenants researched by the Clerk, and draft proposals for site operator signage. The Clerk explained the proposed signage content, was the result of consulting public sites operator signage provided by other local authorities and liaison with the emergency services.

It was queried whether the General Purposes Committee spend time reviewing the report; the Clerk explained the report resulted from councillors' request at the previous meeting of the General Purposes Committee.

It was agreed to defer review of the report to the Allotments Sub-Committee and await its recommendations. Clerk to organise.

c) Moffats Land

It was agreed to defer to the next meeting of the Finance Committee to budget for increasing the height of the wall to the side of the entrance gate.

7. Planning

a) Planning Decisions and Applications

Decisions notified by the planning authority are appended.

The Chairman reported the response from the Planning Authority concerning alterations to glazing of a listed High Street premise. It was agreed a response should be made expressing the appearance of the High Street has been altered and a feature of the said building removed. Clerk to action.

d) Tesco's Shopfront

The Chief Executive's press statement concerning the design of High Street stores and the need for their design to be sympathetic and blend with neighbouring shop design was reported.

It was agreed (Councillor Pitts abstained from the vote) to write to the Chief Executive and request Tesco reconsider the design of it's shop frontage in the High Street, removing the window laminate obscuring the view into the store which would harmonise the premises with neighbouring shops.

Councillor Nation left.

8. Floral Crediton

The Clerk reported:-

- All Town Council displays had now been erected and the planters at the Town entrances planted with marigolds.
- Joint Town Square display baskets would be put up imminently following preparation
 of the street lamp hangers. These baskets were additional to those budgeted and
 may result in overspend; it was hoped this would be limited by the reduced
 requirement for watering resulting from the new larger hanging baskets with water
 reservoirs built in.

• Union Terrace hanging troughs were smaller than ordered and this was being followed up.

Details of the competition and entry form were noted and approved.

Councillors Edwards and Pitts agreed to help with judging.

It was agreed Chamber of Commerce, Schools and Public Houses should be sent entry forms.

9. Highways

A written report from Highways Authority explaining the reasoning for the reversal of traffic flow in North Street was noted. The pre-meeting circulation of this report including a request for any councillor still wishing a presence of the Highways Officer at the meeting to advise the clerk had resulted in no response from councillors, hence no officer presence was requested.

A motion to request an Officer from Highways to attend Council failed, the majority being of the opinion the written report was comprehensive. Councillors Adams and Pitts requested their vote in favour of this motion be recorded.

The guidance issued for Town And Parish Councils interested in adopting the powers was noted, however it was felt the powers not relevant to a Council of a town the size of Crediton.

12. Byelaws

A discussion paper from central government on the future of bye-laws and the creation of a new power for Town and Parish Councils to help deal with anti-social behaviour was noted.

13. Town Square

a) Granite Columns.

It was recommended the Town Council embrace ownership and maintenance of the granite columns as they were given to the people of Crediton.

b) Leaflet.

Content for the production of a Town Square history was reviewed. It was recommended the Council did not sponsor a separate leaflet but considered incorporating the history in an update of the Town Trail brochure.

14. Weed Clearance

It was recommended to continue with the current system and continue to utilise chemical weed killers, given the visual improvement of recent years using this strategy.

15. Blue Plagues

A report suggesting a revision to the wording was received, and it was recommended to change the wording in the plaque to "maybe" as recommended in the report.

16. Litter Pick

It was recommended the Council did not accept the request to co-ordinate litter picking in the town, but support the District Council in its endeavours. Councillor Haydon requested his vote against this motion be recorded.

OBJECTION - Object on the grounds of:-

- 2. Impact on Air Quality by additional traffic generated; Policy CRE6 vii) Stipulates the design and layout to minimise air quality impact.
- 3. Increasing concerns at the cumulative impact of recent developments including those to the west of the Town are having on the road infrastructure.

It was also noted that a previous appeal for development of the site resulted in rejection; Appeal 1 App/5182/A/80/11407.

County Hall records show a total of 45 accidents on Exeter Rd between 1992-2005, resulting in 21 casualties 4 being serious.

The Town Council requests that should this application go to the Planning Committee, that the meeting considering the application be held in Crediton.
