To review the Council's insurance requirements and consider quotations for insurance cover for the next three years. Copies of the quotations received had been issued with the agenda. It was resolved to enter into a 3-year Long Term Agreement (LTA) with Came & Company at a total cost of £1,718.62 per annum. (Proposed by Cllr Wyer)

To consider the internal audit interim report from the Council's Internal Auditor, Mr Stuart Pollard of Auditing Solutions, for the financial year 2016-2017 and agree any actions. A copy of the report had been issued with the agenda. The Assistant Clerk confirmed that the recommendations provided in the report had been addressed as follows:

- 1. Long-standing cheque has been cleared from the accounting system.
- 2. Step-by-step guide to the finances has been produced and is kept in the back of the red finances folders.
- 3. Stamp has been purchased and is in use.
- 4. Asset register is being updated and will be on the May council agenda.

In addition, the Financial Regulations have been amended.

It was resolved to note the internal audit interim report. (Proposed by Cllr Letch)

The Council Office staff were thanked for their hard work.

To amend the Town Council's Financial Regulations in line with the recommendations of the Town Council's internal auditor, which reflect NALC's model financial regulations. A copy of the amended Financial Regulations had been issued with the agenda. It was resolved to approve the amended Financial Regulations. (Proposed by Clir Letch)

To consider whether any litigation, liabilities or commitments, events or transactions, occurring either during the 2016-2017 financial year or afterwards, have a financial impact on the Town Council and, where appropriate to include them in the accounting statements. Further information had been issued with the agenda. It was resolved that there had been no litigation, liabilities or commitments, events or transactions, occurring either during the 2016-2017 financial year or afterwards, which would have a financial impact on the Town Council. (Proposed by Cllr Letch)

To review the Town Council's Co-option Policy. A copy of the policy had been issued with the agenda. Cllr Downes asked whether a proxy vote could be used if a Councillor is unable to attend the meeting at which the co-option is taking place. Members agreed that this would not be suitable as an accurate judgement cannot be made without seeing the presentations during the meeting. It was resolved to approve the Town Council's Co-option Policy. (Proposed by Cllr Harris)

It was **resolved** to accept the quotation received from Cleveland Containers at a total cost of £1,990 + VAT. (Proposed by Cllr Harris, Cllr Wyer abstained)

To consider hosting and sponsoring a Moor Otter sculpture in Crediton for £500+VAT.

Further information relating to this item had been issued with the agenda. The Assistant Clerk confirmed that Crediton Chamber of Commerce fully support the project and are willing to contribute £250 towards the cost. Crediton Town Team voted not to support the project due to their current commitments.

Cllr Sansom advised members that due to the popularity of the otter sculptures, she arranged for one to be reserved until after the meeting to avoid the Council missing out on the opportunity. As the only suitable location is Crediton Community Bookshop, Cllr Sansom chose Otter 054 'Otterly Alice' which is based on Alice in Wonderland. Members agreed this was a fitting choice. Cllr Sansom also confirmed that there will be 30,000 booklets produced showing all 100 otters, with a map containing directions to each location.

It was **resolved** to host and sponsor a Moor Otter sculpture for £500 + VAT, with the Town Council funding the additional £250 from the General Fund, and for the otter to be located in Crediton Community Bookshop. (Proposed by Cllr Harris)

Members thanked CIIr Sansom for the research and work she has put into this project.

To consider a request to hold an open-air inflatable cinema in Crediton Town in aid of Macmillan Cancer Support. A copy of the request had been issued with the agenda. It was resolved to support holding an open-air inflatable cinema in Crediton Town in aid of Macmillan Cancer Support. (Proposed by Cllr Downes)

- Newcombes Meadow. This location would not be suitable for a bar as it is an alcohol-free zone.
- Town Square. This location may not be suitable for a late-night event.
- Field next to Lords Meadow Leisure Centre.

The Assistant Clerk advised members that it does not look as though the route passes through Stonypark field, however the request should still be considered in case they do go onto the field. It was resolved to grant permission for the Crediton Crunch route to go through Stonypark field. (Proposed by Cllr Wyer)





To consider a request for the grant of £200 allocated to Devon Senior Voice, at the Grants Committee meeting held on 31st January 2017, to be re-allocated to Crediton Dementia Action Alliance and agree a course of action. A copy of the request had been issued with the agenda. The Assistant Clerk advised members that since receiving this request, Devon Senior Voice confirmed that Crediton Dementia Action Alliance (CDAA) would not be able to complete a grant application form by the deadline and CDAA

would not be taking over the Dementia Awareness Days until 2018.

It was resolved to withdraw the £200 grant awarded to Devon Senior Voice as the Dementia Awareness Day is no longer taking place. (Proposed by Cllr Wyer)

This £200 will go back into the 2017/18 grants budget and therefore, if Devon Senior Voice or CDAA wish to apply for funding, a Grant Application can be submitted at any point throughout the year.

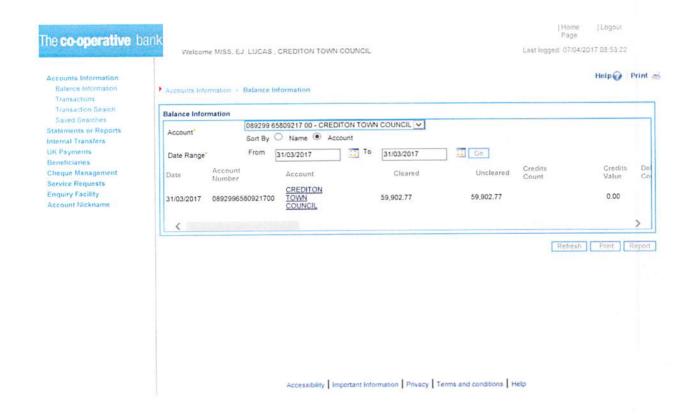
