1 ELECTION OF CHAIR FOR 2024-2025

There is no alternative route.

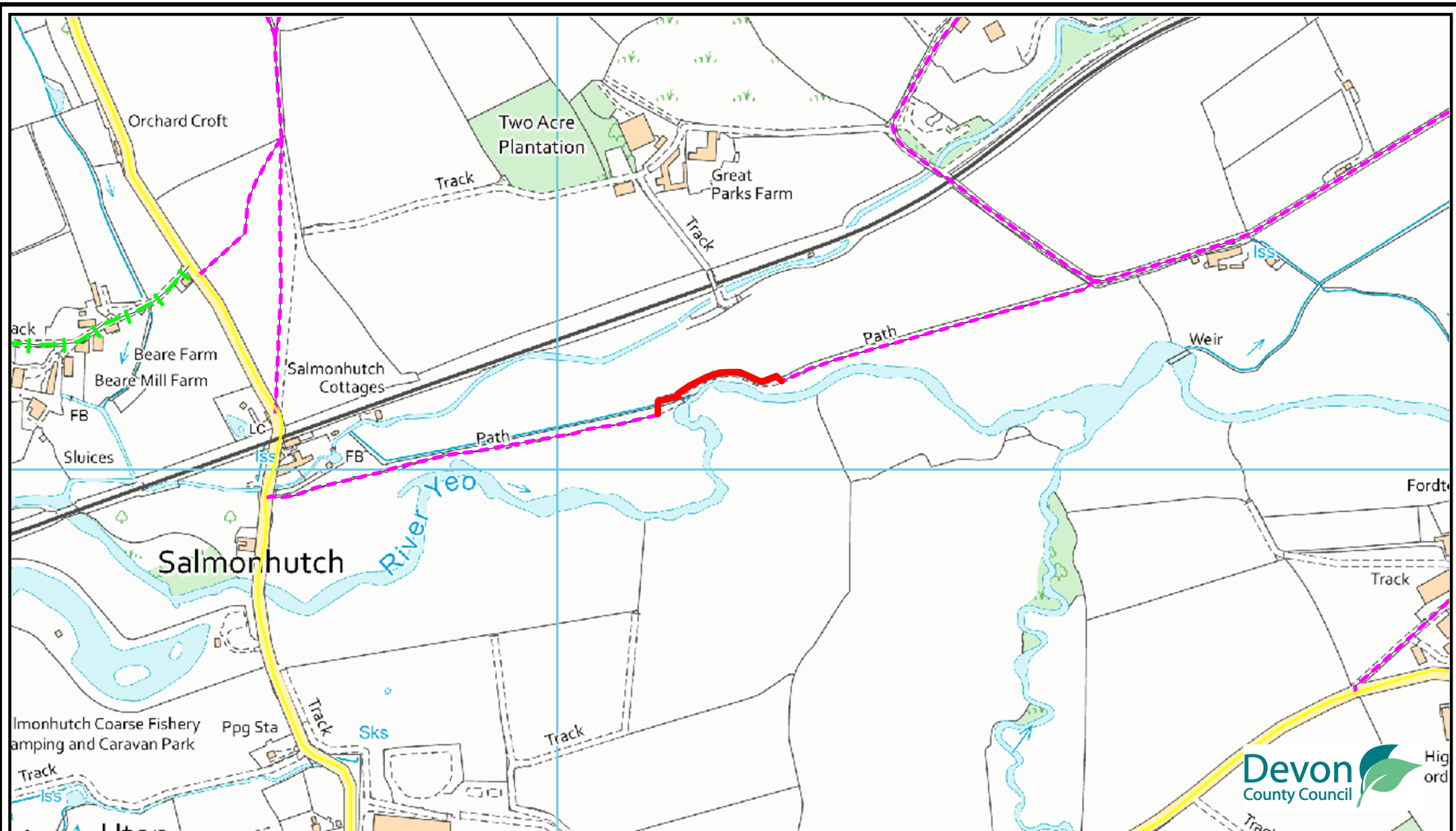
