Following our youth survey last Winter, we know that there are many young people looking for a broader range of opportunities and activities in Crediton. We are keen to recruit a peer educator team to take forward our ambitious programme to meet the needs identified in the survey for:

- An improved skate facility in Crediton and opportunities for young people to visit and enjoy other skate facilities in Devon
- Open mike nights for young people interested in a range of music genres
- Sessions for young carers
- Sessions for quiet young people
- Sessions for LGBTQ+
- Advocating for young people / raising the profile of young people's voice

To support these projects and activities we are looking for Bank Peer Educators with a passion for or skills in skateboarding, art, music and D&D. We are also interested in recruiting Peer Educators to our bank team who have a lived experience of Neurodiversity, as a young Carer, or as a member of the LGBTQ+ community and who are interested in working with us to shape our service to young people in these communities.
